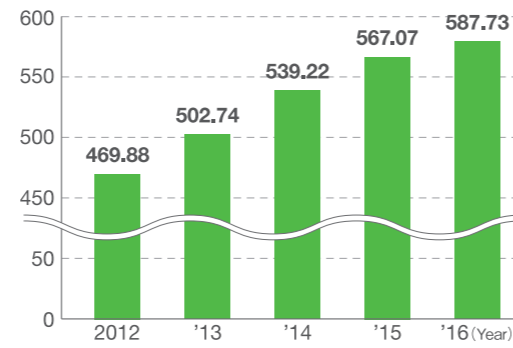

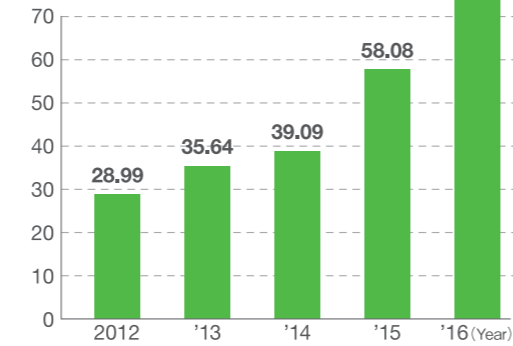

(Consolidated Base)

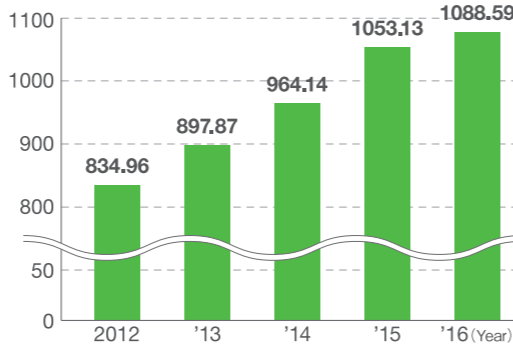
Net Sales (100 Millions of Yen)



Ordinary Profits (100 Millions of Yen)



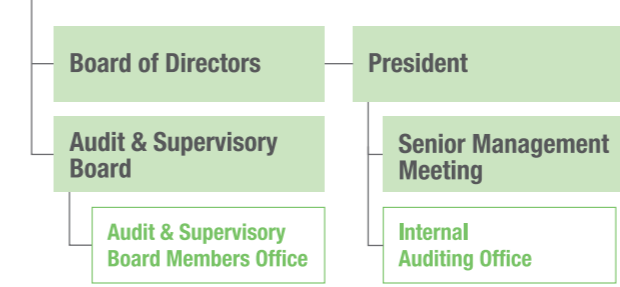
Total Assets (100 Millions of Yen)

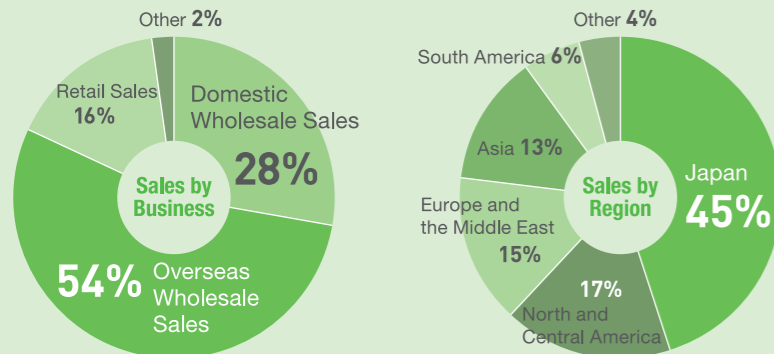
